- **Coastal Medical East Greenwich** is focusing on improving the quality of care and reducing the cost of care for patients with heart failure through pharmacist intervention
- Rhode Island Primary Care Physicians is focusing on care team management of patients with diabetes to reduce preventable Ed/inpatient hospital utilization.
- Women Medicine Collaborative is working on reducing hypertension ED visits by optimizing blood pressure control among women in a primary care practice
- **Thundermist Health Center** is planning on decreasing ED visits and hospitalizations associated with short-term and long-term diabetes complications through the use of team-based care.
- Medical Associates of Rhode Island is focused on pharmacist-directed 24-hour ambulatory blood pressure monitoring in a high-risk population
- **Providence Community Health Center** plans on decreasing ER/IP pediatric asthma related admissions from patients at Capitol Hill.
- Anchor Medical Associates will focus on pharmacist managed remote patient monitoring for high risk heart failure patients
