Revised Measurement Specifications

Look Back Periods for all measures, clarified:

- Denominator: 3 months from end of the measurement period
- Numerator: 12 months from end of measurement period (10 months for EPDS)

EPDS Numerator and Denominator Statements:

- Denominator: The number of active patients who turned 7 months of age during the measurement period
- Numerator: The number of active patients who turned 7 months of age during the measurement period, whose mother had a maternal depression screening at least 3 times (at 3 separate visits) prior to turning 7 months
