



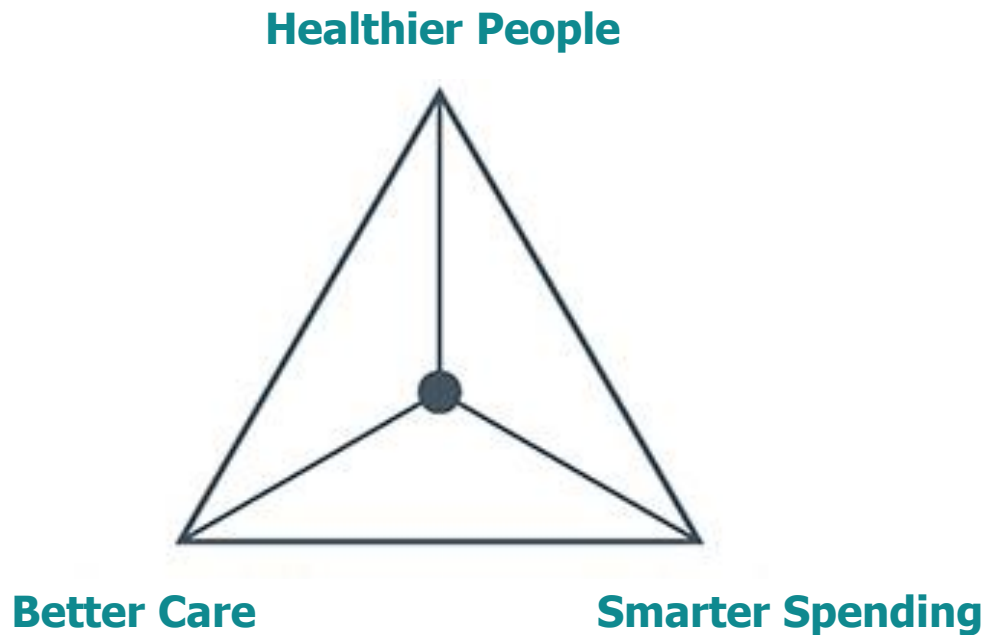

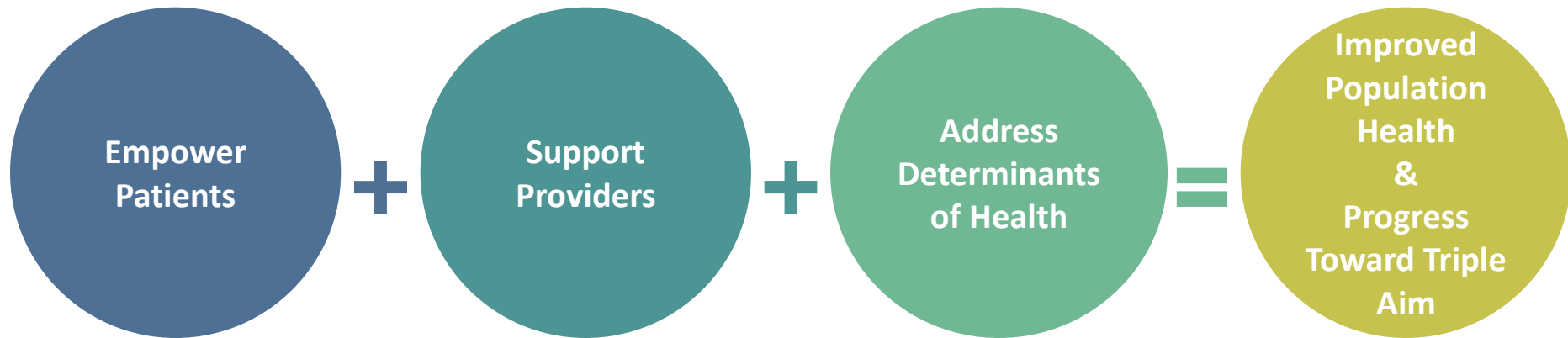

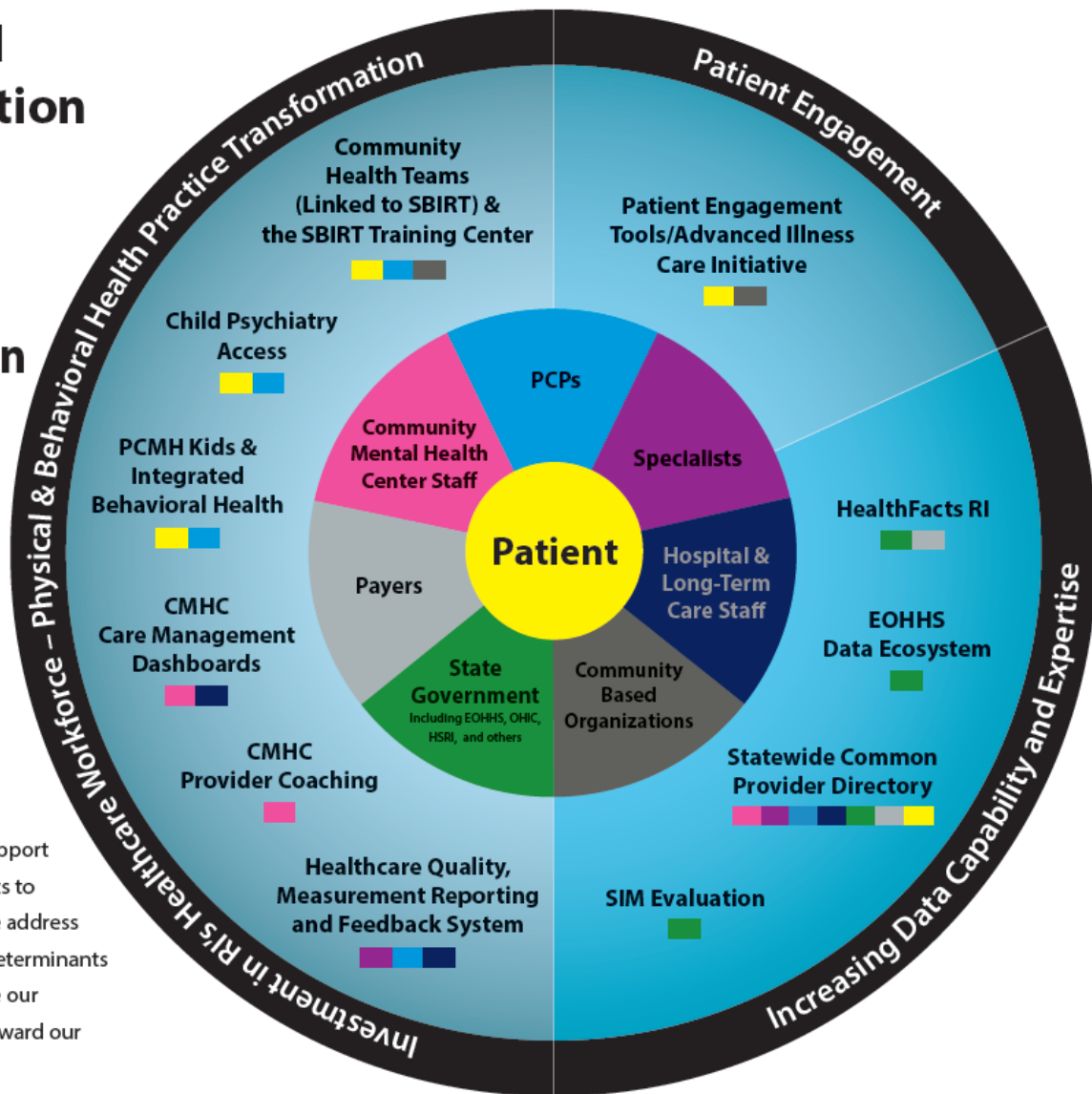
SIM Transformation Wheel
