What is Early Intervention?

Early Intervention (EI) is a program designed to help families support the growth and development of their infants and toddlers, birth through 3, who are delayed in their development or have a diagnosed condition known to cause developmental delay.

How Does it Work?

Early Intervention professionals help families support their child's development in ways that make a meaningful difference. They work in partnership with families to develop child and family goals. El providers help families build upon the things they do every day to support their child's learning and development.

Who Should Seek Early Intervention Services?

- Caregivers, medical professionals or childcare providers who have a concern about a child's development, behavior or how that child participates in everyday activities.
- Caregivers who know a child has had adverse childhood experiences (ACES)

Referrals are always a good idea.
