1) Click on "Practice Reports"


4) Click on "Generate Report"



Below are examples of each report. To return to the summary click “<<Back to Summary Report”.



The vaccines necessary for meeting the Kindergarten requirements that are missing for each child are listed under “Not Met”. These may include vaccines that are “past due” or “due now”.
